# GENERAL

## RECYCLABLES MUST BE:

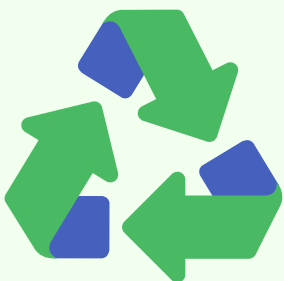
- \*Loose in the cart (No bag!)
- \*Unmixed with trash
- \*Clean and dry
- \*On the curb by 6am on collection day
- \*Not on the curb prior to 6:30pm the day before collection day.

## WHEN YOUR CART IS:

- \*Out, it should be a few feet away from your regular trash cart.
- \*Tagged or empty, it must be brought in by 8am the day after collection.
- \*Tagged, there will be a note explaining the problem needing to be corrected before next collection.

## YOU SHOULD:

- \*Have plastic, metal, glass, paper, box board, and cardboard co-mingling in the cart
- \*Refrain from placing Styrofoam or plastic shopping bags in the cart
- \*Not bundle or bag your recycling



# BY MATERIAL

**METAL:** FOOD CANS WITH LIDS, SODA CANS WITH LIDS, STEEL AND TIN CANS:

\*Rinse cans

\*Labels may remain on

**GLASS :** JARS AND BOTTLES

\*Rinse containers and discard lids

\*Labels may remain on

\*Window glass is not accepted as recycling; please call for bulk pick-up

**BOX BOARD/CARDBOARD:**

\*Empty and flatten all boxes

\*Cut or fold large boxes to 3'X3'

\*Food contaminated boxes are NOT recyclable



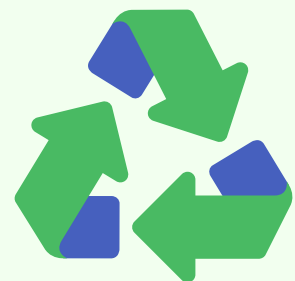
**PLASTIC: ONLY PLASTICS 1-7:**

\*Rinse containers and discard lids

\*Labels may remain on

\*Egg cartons are NOT accepted

**PAPER:**  
NEWSPAPERS,  
MAGAZINES, PAPER  
CARDS, CATALOGS,  
AND POSTERS





# ADDITIONAL

## RECYCLABLE:

- \*Butter and whipped topping plastic tubs
- \*Cans: Aluminum and bi-metal
- \*Milk and beverage plastic bottles
- \*Paperback books
- \*Paperboard: Cereal, shoe, gift, beer/soda boxes
- \*Shredded paper

## NON-RECYCLABLE:

- \*Aluminum foil or aluminum pans
- \*Drinking glasses
- \*Gift wrapping or tissue paper
- \*Hangers
- \*Light bulbs
- \*Mirrors
- \*Pots and pans
- \*Waxed or coated papers or boxes (i.e. milk cartons)
