BM 2/65 do 1/28/65 VMO.M.O. 7/14/65 with co. per telegram from War Dept. dated 1 July 1865. Born in Germany.

⁹⁷ Witnesses to marriage include Peter BECKER and Heinrich JUNGBLUTH.

⁸² Wood County: shows his wife as widowed. Presume Adam is dead by this time. Supports Co. G 17 Wis Infantry data from⁷⁸. Length of war service: 6 months 14 days.

Census listings of sons, Jno and Adam could very well be one in the very same person; possibly a Johann Adam. Based on⁹⁷ showing baptismal sponsor of Adam being Johann Adam; and also the close proximity of ages in census.
